

CAUTION

Read the information below before riding your Dirt or Quad bike.

Riders must comply with local allowable age rule, all local laws and regulations in riding. Minors should never operate this product without adult supervision. DO NOT operate this product under the influence of alcohol or under medical treatment. DO NOT ride the product, without wearing the appropriate safety equipment such as helmet, gloves, kneepads, elbow pads, and any necessary protective equipment your local laws requires. Read your owners manual carefully and always inspect the product prior to each use to ensure it is in safe operating condition. DO NOT operate this product until you can safely start, stop, turn and yield to all obstacles. This product is not intended for use on public roads or highways, near water, sloped driveways or alleyways during nighttime or inclement weather conditions or on slippery or uneven surfaces.

CHECKLIST

New engine break in period

- The engine must be gradually broken-in to ensure engine longevity
- For the first 4-6 hours of use (2 fuel tanks) DO NOT accelerate abruptly or operate at high engine speeds

Starting

- Choke must be up
- Warm engine for approx 5 minutes then put choke down
- Cut-off switch must be on down position
- Key must be inserted and on (where applicable)
- Press brake lever and yellow switch on right hand side (electric start)
- Press the clear priming bulb underneath the carburettor until fuel can be seen (2-stroke)

Fuel

- Make sure that you use the appropriate fuel mixture (where necessary)
- Make sure the fuel is clean
- 4 stroke – unleaded only
- 2 stroke – 25:1 (5 litres unleaded, 200ml 2stroke oil)

Regular Maintenance

- Check and tighten all nuts and bolts (every time you ride)
- Check spark plug
- Check gearbox oil (top-up or change if necessary)
- Check brake lever for hydraulic fluid (top-up)
- Clean air filter
- Lubricate chain, sprocket, and suspension
- Check brake and throttle cable adjustment
- Tyre pressure
- Check and tighten wheel spokes (where necessary)

Charging

- Fully Charge battery before you start the bike for the first time.
- If applicable make sure you fully charge batteries before riding (approx every 2 weeks)
- DO NOT exceed the 24 hour limit when charging
- The charger has a 3-pin plug, never force the plug into the socket

You Should Not!

- Carry or drink a second passenger
- Exceed the max. load limit (refer to product specifications)
